I am so excited for another successful year in our clarinet studio. This past year, our students had another tremendous year of musical growth, including successful All-West auditions, seniors winning college auditions, and beginners who mastered new skills. Parents, your kids rock!

I have a few reminders to help things run smoothly:

Help keep our studio and our families healthy. If your child has the sniffles, stay home. I'm happy to teach online for any reason. If your child is too sick for an online lesson or you need to cancel for another reason, I can offer asynchronous video instruction that you can use any time if you let me know ahead of time. I love our full studio of young clarinetists, but I don't have designated make-up times available.

For weekly lessons, you'll receive an invoice before the beginning of the month. If all the dates look good, send your payment by the 1st of the month to reserve your lesson times.

Clarinetists should always have a few reeds in their case. If your student needs a reed during a lesson, I can usually provide one for \$5. Before you buy a box, I'm happy to make recommendations for your child.
